## <u>OVERVIE</u>W

As a community of students and scholars, the University strives to maintain the highest standards of academic integrity. All members of the community are expected to exhibit honesty and integrity in their academic work. This responsibility can be met only through earnes(canat contee EimAs asug3(thotrt 2air)12.998 1 required in order to replace members or supplement the UAIRB).

2. Academic Integrity Review Panel (AIRP)

In cases of academic misconduct that warrant a panel review, an Academic Integrity Review Panel will be constituted. These panels will be comprised of five (5) faculty members and two (2) student members. In cases involving graduate students, faculty panelists should be graduate faculty and student panelists should be graduate students. In cases involving undergraduate students, the student panelists should be undergraduates.

3. PanelAuthority

Panelsmay prescribe penalties, sustain penalties, reduce penalties, reduce penalties, reduction to no penalty), or dismiss charges, as appropriate to the sec. In subsequent offense cases, as well as those involving alleged academic misconduct beyond the scope of a specific class and/or instructor, the panel may prescribe dismission a program, college, or the University first-offense cases limited to a specific class and/or instructor, however, penalty of the previously prescribed penalty.
